Additional notes:

All countries that have signed the Convention on Cluster Munitions are obliged to cease producing cluster munitions and to destroy stockpiles within 8 years.

Argentina and Serbia, non-signatories to the treaty, have announced that they will no longer produce cluster munitions.

Austria, Belgium, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Germany, the Netherlands, Norway and the United Kingdom are currently destroying their stockpiles of cluster munitions.

Argentina, Australia, Honduras, Mali and Spain have completed the destruction of their stockpiles of cluster munitions.

The Cluster Munition Coalition (CMC) welcomes public statements and information from governments announcing that they have started the process of stockpile destruction and have renounced production.
